



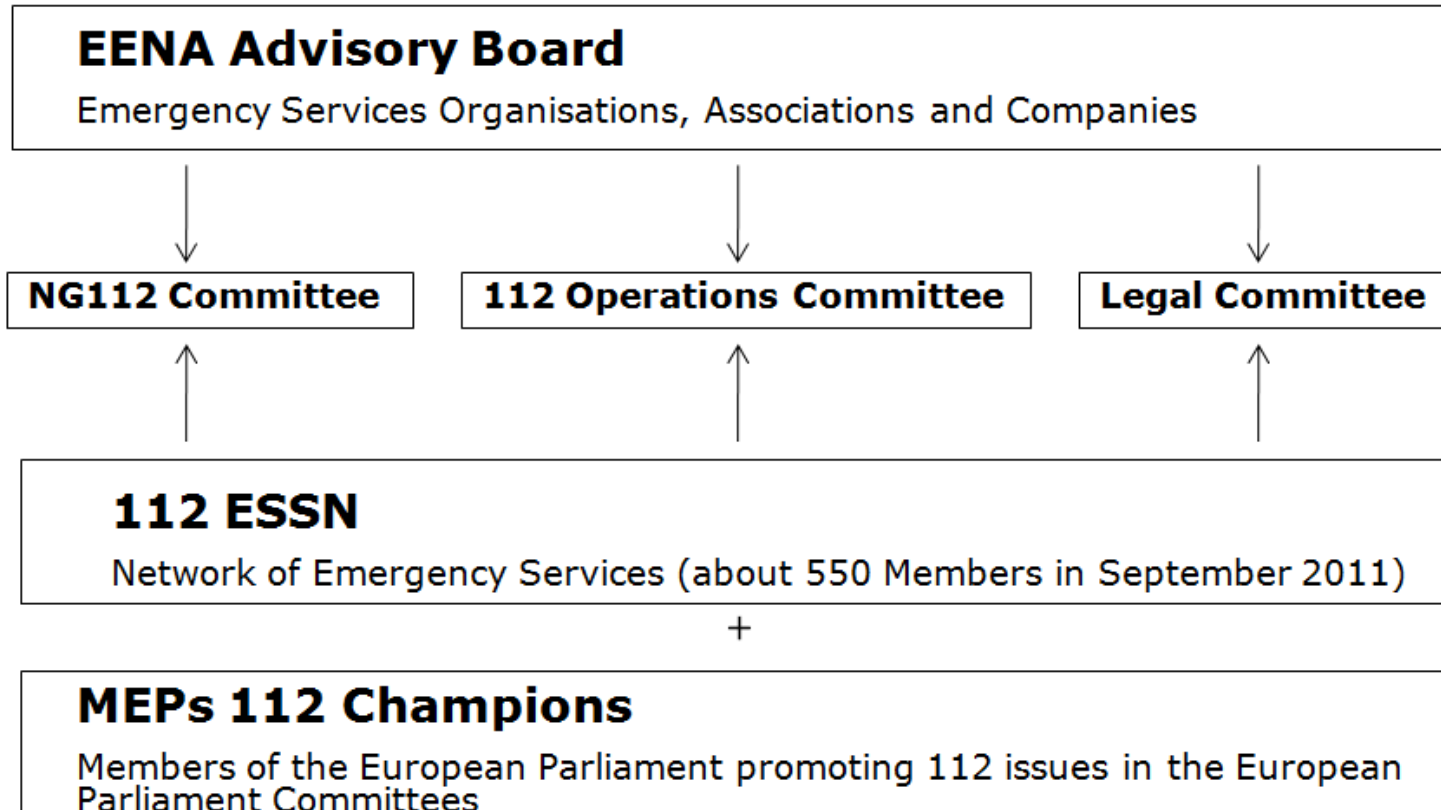

EENA Structure

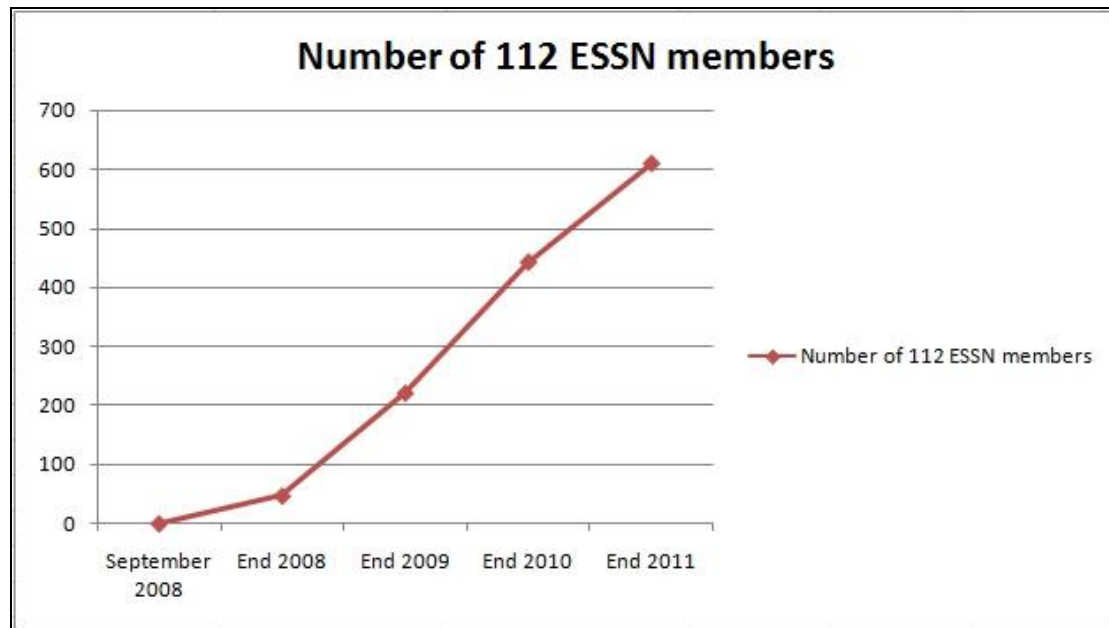

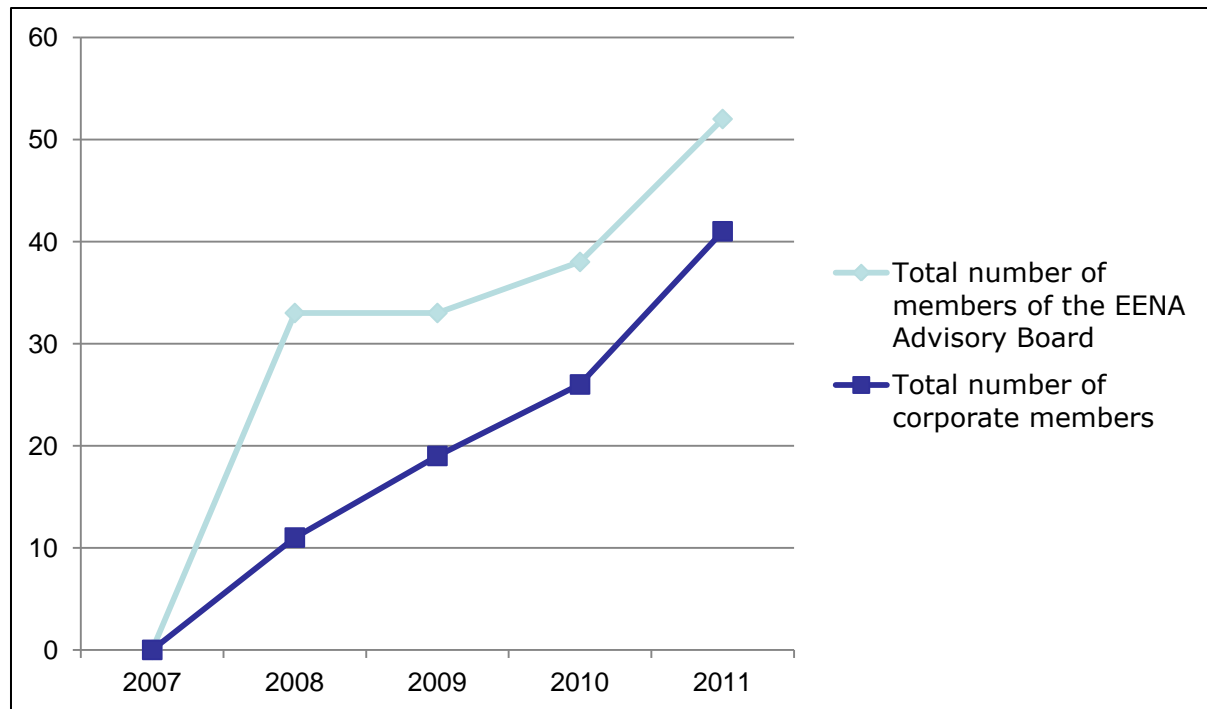
