

Poles amongst best Europeans in an emergency

Poland is among the top three countries whose citizens are most aware of the existence of the 112 Europe-wide emergency phone number.

The latest report issued from Brussels' Eurobarometer program, a series of surveys regularly performed on behalf of the European Commission, says that over 50 percent of Poles call 112 in an emergency. Other nations properly informed about the number include the citizens of the Czech Republic and Luxemburg. On the other hand, only three percent of Italians are aware of the number.

Although the European emergency number functions in all of the European Union countries, the majority of European citizens complain about the information campaign of 112.

Regarding an effectively led campaign, Poland took the seventh place last year according to Eurobarometer. **(is)**
