Only 25 per cent of Austrians know EU emergency number

A Eurobarometer poll shows that only 23 per cent of Austrians know that 112 is the EU emergency number that people in need of immediate assistance should dial.

That compares to an EU-wide average of 22 per cent. Residents of all EU member states can call that number free-of-charge in all EU member states except Bulgaria.

Austrian MEP Othmar Karas, the head of the ÖVP Europe Club, said that one problem in regard to use of the number was language.

He noted the need to deal with thousands of foreign tourists visiting Austria who couldn't speak German.

Even if they could speak some German, they might not be able to do so if suffering from shock after an accident, he said.

The EU Commission is working on making 112 a true European number that will feature the same technical standards in all member states.

Ocean Ranger Drilling Rig Sinks off Coast of Newfoundland (1982)

The *Ocean Ranger* was a semi-submersible mobile offshore drilling unit that sank in Canadian waters on February 15, 1982, killing all 84 crewmembers on board. The crew had been drilling an exploration well in the Grand Banks area, 267 kilometers (166 miles) east of St. John's, Newfoundland, for Mobil Oil of Canada, Ltd. when a sudden storm struck the rig.
